

COVID-19 Information

COVID-19 remains with us, but unlike at the start of other quarters, we have effective interventions and treatments. Current dominant variants are also less severe—with fewer hospitalizations and deaths. With high vaccination rates, over 95% on campus, we are seeing more individuals take personal responsibility for their health and the health of others.

COVID-19 Testing

- DU offers free COVID-19 testing for all students, faculty and staff at the DU Care Pod.
- The DU Care Pod is located in the parking lot of the Richie Center, 2240 Buchtel Blvd. Denver, CO
- Care Pod hours are Monday – Friday 8am – 4pm and Sunday 9am – 1pm.
- No appointment is required, and test results are available often within 24 hours.
- You can view your test results by visiting www.myhealth.du.edu.

When to Test

- Test as often as you like, just not more than once per day.
- Testing is not mandatory, unless you are instructed to test by the DU Contact Tracing Team. If instructed to test you must test on the exact dates provided in the communication. Failure to test will result in suspension of campus access.
- Test after having close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer) of a person you know has tested positive for COVID.
- Test if you have any COVID symptoms, such as:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose

Testing Positive

- If you test positive using a home test or a test not taken at DU, **you must report it to us.**
- Report the test by calling 303-871-2683 or emailing reportcovid@du.edu.
- If you test positive, don't panic we are here to help you. You are not in trouble we want to keep you safe and healthy. We are here to support you.
- State public health orders require that anyone that tests positive isolate for a period of 5-10 days.
- If you live on campus, Housing and Residential Education will reach out to discuss your unique circumstances and assess the need for temporary housing.
- Contact Tracing will give you instructions, follow them and reach out if you need support.
